

Hospital Reports \$122,000 Loss for January

By Elizabeth Jordan News Editor

Washington County Regional Medical Center reported a net loss of \$122,497 for January, the fifth month of their fiscal year.

WCRMC's CEO/CFO Antoine Poythress explained that gross revenue for the month was \$5.79 million; he noted that this total was \$1.5 million above their budgeted numbers.

discussing the When reasons for the increase in gross revenue, Poythress stated the primary driver was the charge master increase (price increase).

"The overall objective is the increase in the charge master is to try to achieve a \$500,000 increase over the next 12 months," said Poythress. "It was necessary because we continue to lag behind our competitors as it relates to pricing." Poythress stated that this

is the second charge master increase the hospital has seen recently. The previous increase took place last year. "This second increase is

to facilitate a little bit more of a turnaround plan," said Poythress, noting that the "jump in revenue" for hospital related service primarily due to the charge master increase.

Poythress added that that the hospital's increase in patient volumes due to the flu season also helped with hos-

pital revenue.

"We had a major increase in ER visits due to the flu season," said Poythress. "During the flu season we did see a major increase in visits throughout the system as it relates to outpatients visits into the ER, into our Family Practice, and into our Peds Practice.'

Poythress explained that the three locations (ER/Family Practice/Peds) had record patient volumes in January.

"It is strictly, 100 percent due to the flu season because after the season went, we saw the volumes drop back to the normal levels," said Poythress.

deductions Revenue for the month totaled \$4.04 million, which is the highest month the hospital has seen this fiscal year. Poythress explained that revenue deduc-

tions are at 69.82 percent of gross patient revenue.

"This is by far the highest percentage, but it's necessary due to the increase in the charge master," said Poy-

CEO/CFO Poythress remarked that the hospital will not see additional money from the Medicare program with the charge master increase.

Board member Terry Jackson questioned Poythress about the average increase of the charge master; Poythress stated that it was a 30 percent increase (weighted average increase).

"The straight increase was very low to just a minor increase because we did lower the cost of some items we're not using," said Poyth-

Poythress continued by

saying that the weighted average increase is "a decent size increase" because they are items that the hospital is

Operating expenses for the month of January totaled

\$1.889 million. Poythress stated that the net loss for the month was \$122,497 (which includes the non-operating expenses associated with management fees from ERH Healthcare).

"Overall, it was a fairly good month," said Poythress. He added, "We're doing good and showing some sign of improvement.'

The net loss for the five months of the fiscal year is \$1,222,409. The loss from routine operations for the fiscal year is \$1,392,474.
